No. MSTET/11-1 It is notified for information of all concerned that as per the instruction of the Government of Manipur, the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur will conduct the State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) as per schedule and details given below:

1. Issue of Application Forms:-From 26-07-2011 to 03-08-2011*.
2. Last Date of Submission of Application Forms:-03-08-2011.
3. Issue of Admit Cards:-From 17-08-2011 onwards (at Imphal, place to be notified later)
4. Date of Examination:-28-08-2011 (Sunday).
 - a) Paper-I 9.30 am to 11.30 am (two hours)
 - b) Paper-II 12.30 pm to 2.30 pm (two hours)
5. Fees (cash only):
 - i) General-Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred only) per paper. (for two papers=600/-)
 - ii) OBC/ST/SC/Physically Challenged-Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred fifty only) per paper (for two papers = Rs.500/-)
6. Eligibility:- The persons with the following qualifications are eligible to appear in the State TET:
 - A) For classes I to V - Senior Secondary (or equivalent) with at least 50% marks.
 - B) For classes VI to VIII - Graduation with at least 50% marks.

THE STATE TEACHER ELIGIBILITY TEST

Guideline for State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET)

In accordance with the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 23 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009, which has been implemented in Manipur, the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) had vide Notification dated 23rd August, 2010, laid down the minimum qualifications for a person to be eligible for appointment as a teacher in classes I to VIII. It had been inter alia provided that one of the essential qualifications for a person to be eligible for appointment as a teacher in any of the schools referred to in clause (n) of section 2 of the RTE Act is that he/ she should pass the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) which will be conducted by the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur, in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE.

The rationale for including the TET as a minimum qualification for a person to be eligible for appointment as a teacher is as under:

- i) It would bring national standard and benchmark of teacher quality in the recruitment process;
- ii) It would induce teacher education institutions and students from these institutions to further improve their performance/ standard;
- iii) It would send a positive signal to all stakeholders that the Government lays special emphasis on teacher quality

Frequency of conduct of State TET and validity period of the certificate:

The test will be held every year and the validity of the qualifying certificate will be seven years. There will be no restriction on the number of attempts a person can take for acquiring the State TET certificate. A person who has qualified State TET may also appear again for improving his/her score. However, qualifying the State TET would not confer a right on any person for recruitment/employment as it is only one of the eligibility criteria for appointment.

State TET Exam Pattern:

The State TET is being held for finding teacher eligibility for teaching two groups of students:

- i) One has to appear Paper I if He/she wants to teach in Class I-V.
- ii) One has to appear Paper II if he/she wants to teach in Class VI-VIII.
- iii) One has to appear both Paper I and Paper II if he/she wants to teach in Class I-VIII.

One has to obtain minimum 60% marks for general candidates and 50% for OBC, ST, SC and Physically Challenged candidates in these papers to qualify in State TET, following which TET certificate would be given which will be valid for 7 years.

There is no restriction to the number of times one can appear in TET - also even after getting 60+% marks or 50+% marks noted above, one can appear in State TET again to know his/her score.

Nature and Standard of State TET questions:

For classes I to V

The test items on Child Development and Pedagogy will focus on educational psychology of teaching and learning relevant to the age group of 6-11 years. They will focus on understanding the characteristics and needs of diverse learners, interaction with learners and the attributes and qualities of a good facilitator of learning.

The Test items for Language I will focus on vocabulary, Parts of speech, Sentence Improvement, Determiners, Marks of punctuation, Phrases and idioms, Passage completions.

The Language II will be from among the prescribed options other than Language I. A candidate may choose any one language from the available language options and will be required to specify the same in the application form. The test items in language II will also focus on the elements of language, communication and comprehension abilities.

The test items in Mathematics and Environmental Studies will focus on the concepts, problem solving abilities and pedagogical understanding of the subjects. In all these subject areas, the test items will be evenly distributed over different divisions of the syllabus of that subject prescribed for classes I-V, by the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur.

The questions in the tests for Paper I will be based on the topics prescribed for classes I-V, but their difficulty standard, as well as linkages, could be up to the secondary stage.

For classes VI to VIII

The test items on Child Development and Pedagogy will focus on educational psychology of teaching and learning, relevant to the age group 11-14 years. They will focus on understanding the characteristics, needs and psychology of diverse learners, interaction with learners and the attributes and qualities of a good facilitator of learning.

The Language II will be a language other than Language I. A candidate may choose any one language from among the available options and as in the specified list in the application form and attempt questions in the one indicated by the candidate in the application form by him. The Test items in Language II will also focus on the elements of language, communication and comprehension abilities.

The test items in Mathematics and Science, and Social Studies/Social Science will focus on the concepts, problem solving abilities and pedagogical understanding of these subjects. The test items of Mathematics and Science will be of 30 marks each. The test items will be evenly distributed over different divisions of the syllabus of that subject as prescribed for classes VI-VIII by the Board.

The questions in the tests for Paper II will be based on the topics of the prescribed syllabus of the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur for classes VI-VIII but their difficulty standard as well as linkages could be up to the senior secondary stage.

Eligibility

The persons with the following qualifications are eligible to appear in the State TET.

I. For classes I to V

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks

II. For classes VI to VIII

Graduate with at least 50% marks.

The candidates appearing in the Manipur State TET will be issued a mark-statement by the Board and the candidates securing 60% and above marks for general candidates and 50% and above marks for OBC, ST, SC and Physically challenged candidates will be issued TET Certificate. Qualifying the State TET would not confer a right on any person for recruitment/employment as it is only one of the eligibility criteria for appointment.

Time: Paper I - 9.30 am to 11.30 am (two hours).

Paper II - 12.30 pm to 2.30 pm (two hours).

Examination Centre : To be held at Imphal only.

Instructions for Filling-in the Form

Candidates must follow the following instructions strictly.

Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.

Incomplete Forms and without the prescribed fees will be rejected.

The candidate must retain a photocopy of his/her filled-in Application Form for future reference.

The candidate appearing State TET is required:-

- i) to go through this Information/Instructions carefully and acquaint with all the information;
- ii) to satisfy eligibility to appear at the examination;
- iii) to submit only the prescribed Application Form complete in all respect;
- iv) to write complete mailing address with Postal Pin Code in the Application Form in capital letters only;
- v) to fill in the Application Form in his/her own handwriting in CAPITAL LETTERS in English only by using black ball point pen and within the boxes only;
- vi) do not overwrite, cut, erase, fold the Application Form and incomplete form may lead to rejection and it should be avoided. Any error arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidate;
- vii) If a candidate submits more than one Application Form for the same paper, his/her candidature shall be liable to be cancelled and the candidate will be debarred for future examination(s);
- viii) Furnishing of false, wrong or inaccurate information may lead to cancellation of the Test results and actions will be taken up as per rules of the Board.
- ix) No request for re-checking, re-assessment, re-evaluation or scrutiny of OMR answer-sheets will be entertained.
- x) No Application Form for the examination will be received after the last date.
- xi) Appearing in the State TET does not imply that the candidates' eligibility has been verified. It does not vest any right with the candidate for appointment. The eligibility shall be, finally, verified by the concerned appointing authority.

For Sl. Nos. 1 & 2 of the Application Form:- Candidate should write his/her name, Mother's name, Father's name/ Husband's name (in case of married woman) in CAPITAL letters. One box should be left blank between each part of the name. Before filling in the Application Form, write on a plain paper and verify the correctness of spellings. Only one letter should be filled in one box as shown below:
